Songstress Miss Foy is an award-winning actress, symphony concert performer and recording artist whose career spans from New York's Carnegie Hall, Tokyo's NHK Symphony Orchestra and London's Philharmonic Orchestra. As an original cast member of the New York Musical hit "Song of Singapore", Ms. Foy received a New York Outer Critics Circle Award for her performance.
